



The Kitchen Scoon on Roast Beef on Weck

Favorite foods from the past can leave very strong memories. A favorite treat growing up was roast beef on weck — delicious thinly sliced roast beef dipped in au jus, topped with some horseradish, and served on a Kaiser roll prepared with coarse salt and caraway (kummelweck) seeds. It wasn't until I left the area that I learned this delicious sandwich is primarily found only in Western New York State where I was raised. On a trip back east recently visiting family I enjoyed another beef on kummelweck. Here's how you can make some yourself.



Roast Beef on Weck

Kummelweck Rolls

- 2 Tablespoons Coarse Salt
- 2 Tablespoons Caraway Seeds
- 1 Cup Water
- 1 Tablespoon Cornstarch
- 1/2 Cup Water, warmed
- 12 Hard or Kaiser Rolls



Mix salt and caraway seeds; store in a clean, tightly covered jar. Boil 1 cup of water; add cornstarch to 1/2 cup warmed water stirring to dissolve. Add this mixture to the 1 cup of boiling water and continue to boil until mixture coats the back of a spoon. Cool. Store in refrigerator.

Heat oven to 350 degrees. Brush water/cornstarch mixture on the top of each roll. Sprinkle with salt/seed mixture. Place on a baking sheet and bake for 4 minutes or until dry.

Beef on Weck Ingredients

- 1 Cup Au Jus reserved from roasting beef
- 20 Ounces Thinly Sliced Roast Beef
- 3 Ounces Prepared Horseradish

Heat au jus to a simmer. Dip sliced beef in au jus, place on bottom half of Kaiser roll. Top with a dollop of horseradish. Dip top of roll in au jus prior to serving...and enjoy!

1 can black beans - drained & rinsed

2 cans corn - drained

2-3 tomatoes - diced

 $\frac{1}{2}$ bunch cilantro - chopped

 $\frac{1}{2}$ purple onion - diced

3 jalapeno's - seeded & diced

1 Tbsp olive oil

Juice from 1 lime

Sea salt to taste

3 cups flour

2 cups sugar

4 Tbsp. cocoa

2 tsp. baking soda

Sift above ingredients in a large bowl then add:

2 Tbsp. vinegar (cider)

2 tsp. vanilla (you can add kaluha or cold coffee


for added chocolate taste)

Mix until smooth, don't beat.

Bake in a 9 \times 13" ungreased pan at 350 degrees for 25 - 30 minutes

Remove from oven and cool. Dust with powdered sugar or frost.
