Congratulations to Sam and Donna Rindskopf who have started a new business endeavor. We wish them all the best and much success.

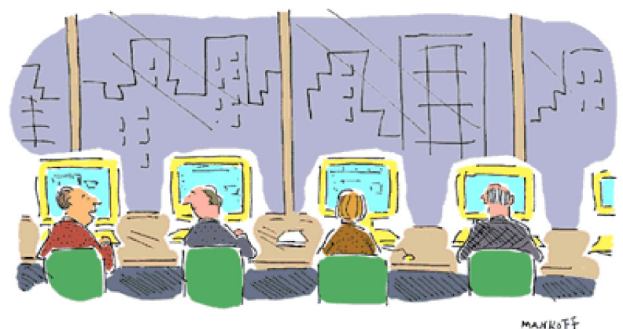
Thank you to Tom and Nancy Geiman for hosting our last get together.

I spoke to Steve Waldron today about cruising grand. IT is back on, with Steve leading it. He has a board and plans are in place to continue it.

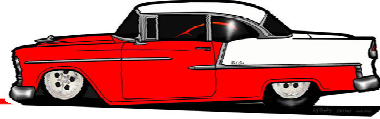

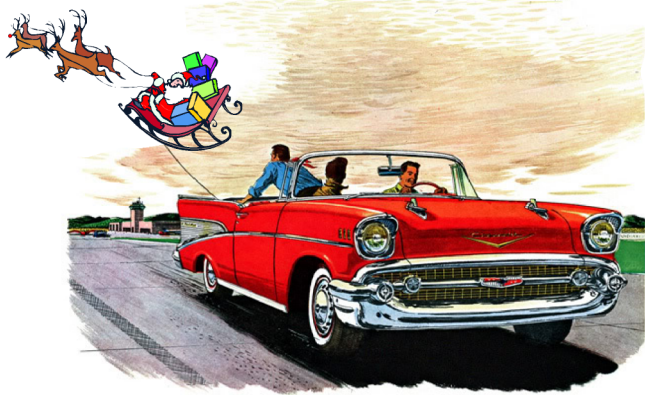

Paula Deen's Chocolate Goosey Butter Cookies

Yield: 3 dozen

I think of the Food Network's Paul Deen as the kitchen goddess of all things decadent -- her recipes always seem to be loaded with butter, cream and all things good. I substituted 1/3 less fat cream cheese in this recipe and used margarine in place of the more expensive butter. I did not re-sugar the cookies following baking. Hope you enjoy these as much as my family does.

Ingredients

- 1 (8-ounce) brick cream cheese, room temperature
- 1 stick butter, at room temperature
- 1 egg
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 (18-ounce) box moist chocolate cake mix
- Confectioners' sugar, for dusting

Directions

Preheat oven to 350 [degrees](#) F.

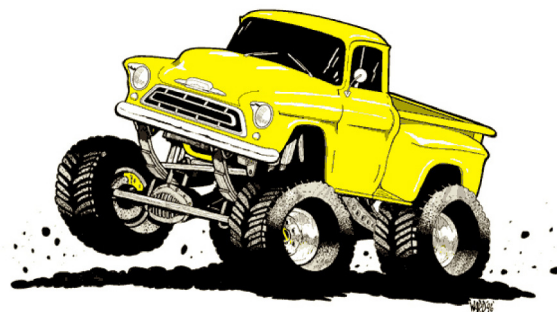
In a large bowl with an electric mixer, cream the cream cheese and butter until smooth. Beat in the egg. Then beat in the vanilla extract. Beat in the cake mix.

Cover and refrigerate for 2 hours to firm up so that you can roll the batter into balls.

Roll the chilled batter into tablespoon sized balls and then roll them in confectioner's sugar. Place on an ungreased cookie sheet, 2 inches apart. Bake 12 minutes.

The cookies will remain soft and "goosey." Cool completely and sprinkle with more confectioners' sugar, if desired.

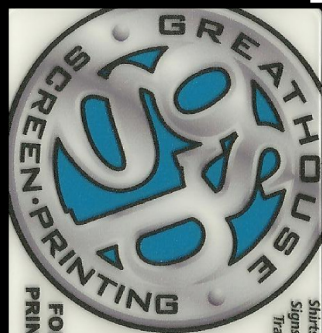

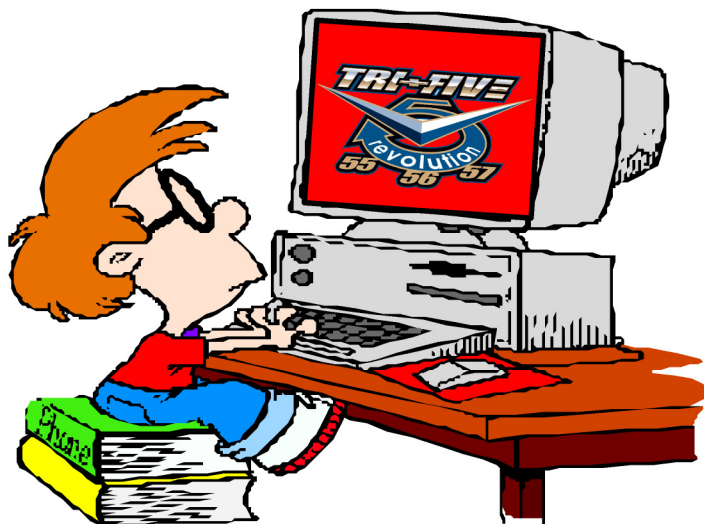
