

TECH TIME

The Final Convertible Update

I spent quite a bit of time visiting numerous upholstery shops before I made my decision on which shop I would choose to create and install the custom interior and top for the convertible project. Several shops I visited either couldn't or wouldn't provide me with the quality and custom design I was looking for. I was not convinced I could get exactly what I wanted until I made a trip to Armando's Custom Upholstery



in San Jacinto. If you have ever been to any of the Good Guys car shows, the Grand National Roadster show, or any other large car show event, you most likely have seen classic and custom cars with interiors that were custom designed and installed by Armando's. Armando's doesn't just do interior upholstery. They are a full custom car business that does custom body fabrication and paint along with most anything you want to have done to your Tri-Five, truck, convertible, muscle car, resto-mod, or traditional restoration.



I chose Armando's because they have been operating their family-owned business for many years and they are an absolute pleasure to do business with. They spent all the time needed to thoroughly listen to my vision and ideas for my project and they went out of their way to suggest ways to make it the best it could be. They really know the upholstery business and their work is as professional as I have ever seen.

They consistently kept me up on the progress by texting photos of design options and asking questions about what I wanted to incorporate into the design. I made one or two trips every week to San Jacinto to observe the progress first hand. I was blown away with what I saw every time.





This project took the better part of eight weeks, and is now complete. I now have an interior and top that is far superior to what I could even imagine in the beginning. The Lexus power bucket seats and the rear seat were repadded and covered with a one-of-a-kind custom design. Door and side panels were designed to complement the seat design. The console was designed to flow with the bucket seats and included a location for the stereo, power points and cup holders. The top is of the best quality

and fit and we added a glass folding rear window to eliminate the problems that inherently plague the plastic ones that look bad the first time the top is folded down. The trunk design was created to accommodate and give access to the battery box, kill switch and amplifier. It looks great, and at the same time it provides for some storage on each side to store things I will want to have in the car.



November 23 was kind of like Christmas for me because that is the day Armando's completed all the tasks, and the convertible was ready to come home. The car is now safely back in San Diego in the shop and it is looking good! There are still a few tasks that need to be completed before it hits the road, but it is essentially ready to go. It seems sort of surreal to me because this project has taken 21 years to complete and there were times when I wondered if it would ever get finished. I have already made plans to take it to numerous car show events and it will be on display in Armando's booth at the Grand National Roadster Show in Pomona in May. I'm really hoping the covid pandemic doesn't cause any of them to be canceled along the way. I'm really looking forward to driving the car instead of just working on it. It is now time to turn up the music and cruise!




