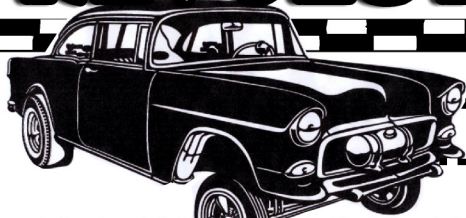

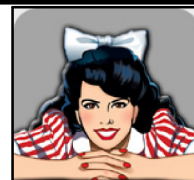


Big 3 Auto Parts Exchange
