TECH TIME Convertible Upaate

Last month, I talked about the issues surrounding the Corvette differential the Chevrolet in convertible project. Since then, I have made significant progress with this project. The differential parts have been powder coated everything has and reassembled with new bearings, seals and u-joints, and installed under the car. As I had hoped, Dana 44 differential fit the perfectly with the other parts. I did have to get a new nose

mount made and I will need to shorten the driveshaft, but all in all, everything seems to be good. I also discovered that Kendall and a few other oil vendors now sell limited slip differential oil with friction modifier already added, so it is no longer necessary to buy the stink oil friction modifier separately. What took them so long?

So, it was time to move on to installing sound deadener under the dash and firewall. I was not happy with the paint job under the dash, as there was still a lot of surface rust and lack of paint. I spent a whole day sanding down the back side of the dash and painted it with gloss black before putting in the sound deadener and the firewall pad. Then came the task of putting the wiring harness back in and trying to everything remember where went.









There are still a few wires to identify and route to their proper location, but it is mostly back in place, as is the brake pedal assembly, accelerator pedal assembly, raingear wipers and cruise control unit. Once I had all of wiring for the the engine compartment in place, as well as the fuel lines to the fuel injection, it was finally time to put the engine and transmission back in the car. This turned out to be one of the easier tasks accomplished this month. It all

went in and was bolted in place in a very short time. The headers are installed too!

I also finished installing all the new brake rotors. calipers and brake lines on all four corners, as well as all of the parking brake components. The brake cylinder. booster, master steering column, steering shaft and exhaust systems will be next up on the list as soon as I get the body to mounts secured. frame Sometimes it seems like progress is slow, but this month, I can see some real definitely progress that



shows. I am hoping to be completely done with the underside of the car by next month. To be continued.



Claudia's Corner

Here is a yummy salad for your Valentine. You can freeze it and take out as much as you need when you need it.

Champagne Salad



Cream together:

1 8 oz. Cream Cheese - softened 3/4 cup sugar

Fold in following ingredients:

2 large sliced bananas

20 oz. crushed pineapple - drained

10 or more marching cherries - optional (I used them, makes it prettier)

1/2 cup chopped nuts (I used a little more than 1/2 cup)

10 oz. frozen strawberries in juice - thawed

1 - 16 oz. container of cool whip - folded in (I only used 8 oz. and it worked great. I thought 16 oz. was too much)

Pour mixture into two loaf pans that are lined with plastic wrap or foil (I used plastic wrap to keep longer in freezer)., fold ends over top of pan and freeze. Or you can make small individual salads by freezing them in small aluminum loaf pans and take out one at a time to use. It will make 4 or 5 small ones.

When you serve the salad, slice while frozen and place on a bed of lettuce on individual salad plates. Do this just before serving because it melts quickly.

This is wonderful for company, you can make it ahead. I always have it on hand for a little extra for dinner!






