



February is here and its still cool in Arizona. Maybe in San Diego, too. So I have a few recipes that might just take the chill off. Happy Valentine's Day to everyone!



Sausage Barley Soup

1 package spicy Italian sausage sautéed in a small amount of olive oil

When sausage starts to brown but is not fully cooked, add the following ingredients in this order:

1 large spanish onion diced

6 large garlilc cloves minced

saute for about 15 minutes on low

3 large fresh carrots diced

4 stalks celery cleaned of leaves and diced

1 Tbsp. Old Bay seasoning

Saute for 20 minutes on medium to brown the veggies

Add: 4-6 diced med red potatoes & sauté for a few more minutes

Add: 1 28 oz canned diced tomatoes

1 cup of barley

Add beef or chicken broth to cover mixture by

about 3 inches of liquid

Simmer for about 2 1/2 hours and serve

SOUTHWEST WHITE CHILI

1 Tbsp olive oil

1 ½ lb boneless, skinless chicken breast cut into small cubes

½ cup chopped onion

1 cup chicken broth

1 (4oz) can chopped green chilies

1 (19oz) can white kidney beans, undrained

2 green onions, sliced

1 tsp garlic powder

1 tsp ground cumin

½ tsp oregano leaves

½ tsp cilantro leaves

1/8 tsp ground red pepper



Heat oil in large saucepan over med-high heat. Add checken and onions; cook 4 – 5 minutes.

Stir in broth, green chilies & spices; simmer about 15 minutes

Stir in beans. Simmer 5 min. Top with onions. Garnish with Monterey Jack cheese if desired. Makes 4 cups.

PORTUGUESE SOUP

3 cans chicken stock or canned broth

1 lb smoked kielbasa sausage, diced

1 lb boiling potatoes, peeled & diced

1 (15 1/4oz) can kidney beans, drained

1 (14 1/2oz) can diced tomatoes

½ medium head cabbage, coarsely chopped

1 med onion, chopped

1 large carrot, diced

½ green bell pepper, diced

3 garlic cloves, minced



Combine all ingredients in a large pot. Bring to a boil, stirring occasionally. Reduce heat; simmer until thick, stirring occasionally, about 2 hours. Season with pepper.

OK to use crock pot.




