The Last Pepper Tree Frosty Faux Burger Run

Pretty much everyone who has been in the San Diego area for any length of time has been to or at least heard of the Burger Run at the Pepper Tree Frosty in Vista. The story goes that it all started in 1988 with four car guys making a trip to the Pepper Tree Frosty to get a burger. They decided to make it a regular thing with free tee-shirts, dash plaques and unique trophies, and by the second year there were about 100 participants. It grew into a major event attracting over 500 vehicles and thousands of spectators to the downtown area. Over the decades, the Burger Run became recognized as one of the first major car shows of the season and as the "Biggest Little Car Show in San Diego County."

Then came the pandemic in 2020, bringing the Burger Run to a halt along with everything else in our lives. There were efforts to revive the Burger Run last year and it was a nice event despite there being a smaller turnout. Then last May, we received news that the property where the Pepper Tree Frosty and Danny's Donuts are located is going to be redeveloped into a new mixed-use building with apartments and retail, including a smaller, modernized Frosty run by the same Villasenor family, preserving their legacy while updating the site.

With this news, it appears the last and final Pepper Tree Frosty Faux Burger Run would be on January 10, 2026. We decided we would go to be a part of the legendary last Burger Run. When we arrived around 8 am, it was a very chilly 44 degrees outside. We visited Danny's Donuts for hot chocolate & donuts to help ward off the chill. The chilly temps didn't stop the crowd from showing up. It was difficult to know just how many cars were in attendance as they were coming and going all morning and because the parking lot was full, people were parking on the street and in other parking lots in the area. My best guess is there was somewhere between 125 and 150 cars.

Is this really the end of the Burger Run? It seems there is little information available as to a timeline when the Pepper Tree and Danny's Donuts will close their doors for the last time. Like so many things in our lives, it appears that the annual Burger Run will soon just be a memory of our past.

Local Car Scene in Winchester

It was sponsored by the Local Car Scene presenting a car show in Winchester at the Wild West Social Saloon from 11:00 am to 3:00 pm. That's not exactly in the San Diego area, but we hadn't been to a real car show other than the Pepper Tree Frosty Faux Burger Run since early December. We had no other plans and the weather looked like it would be a nice warm day, so we decided to go.

We cleaned up the car, gassed it up and headed north, arriving in Winchester a few minutes before 11 am. Then it was time to head out, but we didn't head for home. Instead, several of us went to Richie's Real American Diner in Murrieta for ice cream treats. We shared a banana split and shared a few stories before calling it a day and heading home.






CHERRY ENCHILADAS

From the Kitchen of Claudia Gayhart

- 1/2 cup water
- 1/2 cup butter
- 1/2 cup white sugar
- 5 (10 inch) flour tortillas
- 1 (21 ounce) can cherry pie filling
- 2 tablespoons white sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1 tablespoon crushed sliced almonds



1. Grease a 9x13 inch baking dish. Combine the water, butter and 1/2 cup of sugar in a small saucepan and bring to a boil. Place a few spoonfuls of cherry pie filling just slightly off center of each tortilla. Roll up and place seam side down in the baking dish. Pour the hot liquid over the 'enchiladas' making sure to coat the tops completely. The mixture will be watery. Cover and refrigerate overnight.
2. Preheat the oven to 375 degrees F (190 degrees C). Combine 2 tablespoons sugar, cinnamon and almonds in a small bowl or cup; sprinkle over the top of the enchiladas.
3. Bake for 35 to 40 minutes in the preheated oven, or until outside edges of the tortillas are golden brown. Let cool slightly before serving.
