The Kitchen Scoop on Comfort Food Soup

As a child, homemade soup was a once-a-winter treat, enjoyed when my father made up a large batch of hamburger soup in my mother's cast iron roasting pan. In my kitchen I make soup quite frequently, especially when the weather's cold, wet and nasty — vegetable barley in the crockpot, or stovetop cream soups when I have fresh vegetables I need to use. Cream of broccoli and cream of carrot are both favorites in our house.

If you want to try something a bit out of the ordinary, here's a recipe for Green Minestrone I think you'll enjoy. The recipe calls for chicken stock; feel free to substitute vegetable stock if you prefer, your soup will be just as delicious.

Green Minestrone

Makes 4 servings

2 Tablespoons olive oil

1 medium onion, chopped

2 ribs celery, chopped

2 large cloves garlic, crushed

1 bay leaf

1 medium zucchini, diced

Salt and freshly ground pepper

1 can white cannellini beans

1 can garbanzo beans

8 cups chicken stock (two 1-quart containers)

1 cup mini penne or other small pasta

1/2 pound green beans, trimmed and cut into 1-inch pieces

10 ounces spinach, well washed, dried on paper towels, stems removed and coarsely chopped

1/2 cup grated parmesan or romano cheese

12-16 leaves fresh basil, torn or shredded, or 1/4 cup shopped fresh flat leaf parsley

Heat a large pot over medium-high heat. Add oil. Once oil is hot, add onions, celery, garlic, bay leaf and zucchini to the pot and season with salt and pepper to taste. Saute for 5 minutes, stirring frequently. Add white beans, garbanzo beans and broth. Cover and bring to a boil. Add pasta and green beans and cook 8 minutes, or until pasta is just tender. Stir in spinach to wilt, about 1 minute. Stir in grated cheese and ladle soup into bowls. Top with basil or chopped parsley.






