

Do You Have a Car with Keyless Entry?



I recently saw a news story on the theft of cars with keyless entry, cars that use a fob instead of an old-fashioned key. I was surprised to see that 92% of stolen cars were keyless entry models. I wondered how that could be. Unlike standard cars where access without setting off an alarm requires the key, cars with keyless entry can be tricked into thinking the fob is present. How so you ask? These thefts are called "relay attacks" and be easily and quickly done by thieves if your fob isn't protected. A transmitter and a receiving device are used to pick up the fob's radio frequency signal. If your fob is not stored safely, it can be very easy for would be thieves to obtain your fob's radio frequency without having to break into your house. A fob's signal can be intercepted from as far away as 60 feet. One thief will stand outside your house with a device used to capture the frequency and then transmit it to a second thief with a receiving device standing by your vehicle. This tricks the vehicle into thinking the fob is within the range necessary to enter and start the vehicle. Within a minute or two, your cherished ride can disappear.

So, what can you do to stop would be thieves? Most car models with keyless entry have a manual way to turn off the fob's signal. This is a sure-fire way to prevent theft because there is no signal to turn off. However, this method can be a real pain to deal with. There is another easier way to solve the problem. It's called a "blocking pouch", or a "Faraday bag" or "Faraday box." It is a pouch or box

made with a metallic material that blocks the fob's radio frequency from being transmitted to a relay device. Simply put your fob inside and close it up! It also helps to keep it far away from windows and doors while in the pouch or box.

Pouches or boxes can be purchased online at E-Bay, Amazon, and many other websites, and they can be purchased for under \$20.


