The Kitchen Scoop on Burger Accompaniments

Family picnics are a fond memory of summers when I was young. These would include my fathers' parents, Mim and Bert; my Aunt, Uncle and three cousins; and me with my Mom and Dad. Mim would be the organizer of the event and choose the destination: often Johnson's Pond, where we could watch graceful wild swans swim under drooping weeping willows, or Godfrey's Pond, a private area with swimming hole and stocked fishing pond where Bert had a family membership.

The menu was typical of the time when our Tri-5's were new: hamburgers and hot dogs (the old-fashioned ones that snapped when you bit into them), kept cold on the road in a red plaid Skotch Kooler; potato or macaroni salad packed in the "Penguin Bowl", an insulated stainless steel orb with a row of embossed penguins and black bakelite handles (It wasn't until I was writing this article and researching its real name that I learned this was intended to be an ice bucket.); baked beans, the casserole dish wrapped in insulating newspaper then placed in a brown grocery bag; lemonade from a gallon Thermos jug, with watermelon for dessert.


Now days in our family we replace beef burgers with salmon. Here are three toppings that sound to me like they'd be delicious on either type burger you choose.

Cream Cheese and Sour Cream Sauce

Combine 1/2 cup softened cream cheese, the white and green of three scallions finely chopped, 1/2 cup sour cream and 1 teaspoon lemon juice.

Soy Sauce and Slaw

Mix 1/4 cup low sodium soy sauce and 1/4 cup sugar in a very small saucepan. Stir over medium heat for 2 to 3 minutes until syrupy enough to coat the back of a spoon. Add 1-1/2 Tablespoons of the mixture to 3/4 cup mayo. Top your burger with the sauce and a scoop of slaw. Remaining soy sauce mixture will keep indefinitely at room temperature.



Add curry powder to taste to mayo and use it to top your burger.
