CLASSIC CHEVYS CRUISE TO DON'S PARTY GARAGE

When I received the e-mail from Smitty about a cruise he had arranged to Corona to visit a huge privately owned collection of old Neon signs and lots of memorabilia from our past, I just had to sign up for the trip. While I'm not a collector myself, I thoroughly enjoy seeing so many things I remember growing up around and in many cases, things I have never seen before at all.

On June 12, a group of CCSD members met up in the Murphy Canyon Sizzler parking lot and at 9 am, we headed north on I-15 towards Corona. There were eight classics and a couple daily drivers in the group, and we arrived at Don's Party Garage in Corona a little before 11 am. After the initial confusion about how to get onto the property, we were able to drive into the back parking area with our classics.

Don Long and his wife have eight and a half acres on which they built a huge garage type building where they display awesome collections of signs, memorabilia of all kinds, and about thirty classic cars. Inside this huge building, there is so many things to look at, that even after three times through, I was still seeing things I missed on the previous rounds. There is a working Ice Cream Parlor in one corner, a replica old time drug store in the back and a complete working 50's style diner just outside. There are so many lights, neon signs and other things using electricity that a huge diesel generator was running outside to power everything up.

There is an old-time elevator that goes up to the man cave on the second floor where there is a bar, pool table, a bowling machine, juke box, several pinball machines, and a whole bunch of other memorabilia items. It is a working elevator, though it is a little scary to use as it takes off fast, stops fast and has a bit of a jerk about halfway up. Very cool!









There are pedal cars everywhere you look along with display cases with antique collections such as vintage car parts and vintage pieces of garage equipment like jacks, tire changers, battery chargers and battery stands, oil changing and lubrication equipment. There are racks holding oil cans, coke bottles and various other items. There are collections of hammers, scales, coffee cans, fire hose nozzles, sanders, and saws. There is even a Barbie Doll collection. There are Texaco, Standard and Gulf gas stations all surrounded by more memorabilia items.



Among the big signs was a Planet Hollywood marque near the entrance, signs for many familiar car makers, some that are long gone, signs for jewelry, a bakery, paint store, food, car repair services and the list goes on.

The most impressive part of this is that all of this was put together since 1996. And they are not finished yet. Things still come and go and get moved around. And they are currently building a frontier town complete with sheriff's office, bank, barber shop, blacksmith shop and a bar is in the works too. I'm sure I missed seeing everything, which is part of the reason I hope to go back sometime.



After a couple hours of intense exploring and enjoying an ice cream, it was time to go. About half of the group went to Tom's Farm for lunch and shopping before heading on home. All in all, it was a really fun event and perhaps we can do it again. Put this one on your bucket list!






Tri-Five Correspondence






