# 35th Annual Fords and Friends Car

Pick-Ups Limited of San Diego has been hosting the Annual Fords and Friends Car Show for a lot of years, and it has been held at numerous locations over those years. I remember first attending this show in Ramona at Dos Picos County Park. It was on grass and nice except it always seemed to be on another hot day in east county. In recent years the show was at El Monte Park in Lakeside which was not a bad location except for a lot of gopher holes.

Last year's show was in the Diane Jacobs Equestrian Park in Lakeside, which was a terrible location because it was on a dusty decomposed granite parking lot with no paved areas. It was also on a very hot day, and it was just not a real fun location. Fast forward to this year's show on June 13. The venue was moved to NTC Park in Liberty Station. What a huge improvement, a paved parking circular lot with shade trees and temperatures in the low 70's!

As always, this show was open to all years, makes and models of cars as well as classic motorcycles. In short, if it has wheels, you were invited. All proceeds from this show benefit Meals on Wheels, Armed Services YMCA and the Gary Sinise Foundation.



Our day started at our shop where we met up with Rod Hildebrand in his '57 Chevy 150. Linda and I cruised with Rod to the show in our '55 Belair Convertible. We were the only T5R members at the show. As we arrived at NTC Park, there was a bit of confusion by the staff, and we were misdirected to the entrance at first. But they figured it all out and were told to park, then come back to registration to get our placards and goody bags. NTC Park has a long loop parking lot surrounded by trees that provided shade for almost every one of the 110 entrants. There were no bad places to

park except for a couple spots where the tree roots had lifted up the pavement making it challenge to park in them. After parking, we set up a popup and made the cars show ready before heading to registration. While at registration, we checked out the raffle prizes. The big prize item was a Yukon portable work bench still in the box. We got a "Rod" arm's length of tickets for \$20 and put a few of them in buckets for selected items and the rest went in the general raffle.

Then it was time to check out the other entries, vendors and the hot dog stand. Free donuts and coffee were available next to the registration tent near the raffle. There were some really nice cars, about double that of last year, and of course a lot of people we know from other clubs and other shows. One interesting entry was a very tall and very long Ford truck. A ladder or step stool was needed to get in, and it was way too long to fit in a parking space, so it was backed up over the sidewalk to keep the street passable. With Linda standing next to it, she looked like a munchkin. After seeing about all there was to see, we opted for a jumbo hot dog and hung around the cars for a bit watching spectators come by.



Around 1:00 pm, the last of the raffle prizes were handed out and it was almost time for awards. The interesting part was how award winners were notified and how they received their awards. A large green sheet of paper with the words "You Are A Trophy Winner" was placed on the dash of winning cars. Winners were told to check their cars and if they had a green sheet, get into their car and drive it up to the DJ booth to accept the award. Not having looked at the car for a while, I had not seen a green sheet. I went back to look and only saw a stack of flyers on the floor. I picked them up and buried in the middle of the flyers was the green sheet. I lined up the convertible with the rest of the winners. The winner line was in no particular order, and one-by-one each winner received their award at the DJ Booth. Spectators were able to see each of the winners as they came through the line. Our '55 Chevy convertible was awarded the "Best Tri-Five Chevy" trophy.

It was a nice day at a nice location to see a bunch of really nice cars, visit with our fellow car show participants and have a good time. The drive-through trophy presentation was a nice touch, and we hope they keep that tradition going as well as keeping the venue at NTC Park. Good job Fords & Friends!

# Casino Pauma "Let it Ride" Car Show

In our quest to attend car show events that are new to us, we found a flyer for the "Let It Ride" car show brought to us by Casino Pauma and the 5150 Rat Rod Club on May 31. The entry fee was \$35 for show cars and free to all spectators. It was open to classic cars, hot rods, trucks, motorcycles and of course, rat rods. We had heard of Casino Pauma, but we had never been there, and we weren't sure where exactly it is located. A quick check of the map app on my phone revealed it is pretty much in the middle of nowhere about 45 miles north and east of home. We left home around 6:30 and followed the directions on the app, taking us up I-15 to Via Rancho Parkway and Bear Valley Parkway, through Valley Center, over Cole Grade Road and eventually to the Casino on Hwy 76. The casino is a three-tenths mile journey from the highway to the parking lot, and it is not really visible from the highway.

As we entered the parking lot, we could see what looked like a big white tent and a really huge parking lot covered with dozens of overhead solar panels that would provide a lot of shade for the event. The 5150 Rat Rod members were there to greet us, and they directed us to a nice area under the solar along with about 150 other participants. T5R members Sam & Donna Rindskopf were already there, and Sam was diligently detailing their beautiful black 57 Nomad while Donna was staying warm inside the car as it was a bit on the brisk side. That didn't last long as the temperature was warming up quickly.



There were a few food vendors under pop-ups where you could get Indian fry bread, snow cones and few other treats. A 50/50 raffle and a silent auction with some unique one-of-a-kind hand built items were lined up on tables. Right next to those were tables with 24 custom one-of-a-kind hand-made trophies to be awarded to a few lucky winners at the end of the show.



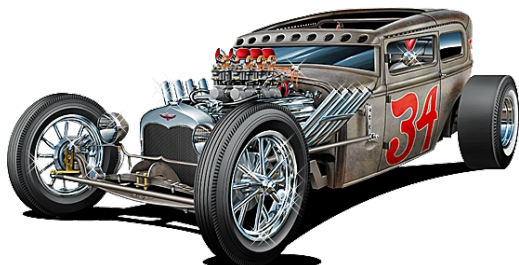
We went inside the big tent to check out the casino. Once inside, it no longer looked like a tent at all, but a really elegant high end Vegas style casino with slot machines everywhere. Rest rooms were as clean and nice as I've ever seen. One thing I had never seen before is the hand driers which were built into the sinks and blew your hands dry over the sink instead of on the floor. There was also a café where breakfast could be had at a reasonable price. Steak and eggs was just \$9.99, but I wouldn't recommend it as it was not great.

Back outside, people were setting up the race track for valve cover races, a highlight of events hosted by the 5150 Rat Rods. There were some very interesting valve cover racers, some very extravagant and some looking more like a real rat rod. The basic rules are they have to be made from a real engine valve cover, and they can't be heavier than ten pounds. Entrants are paired up for a best of three runs. Losers are out and winners go to the next round until they get down to the final two. Both the winner and the runner-up get a cool hand made trophy to celebrate first and second place. The races are a lot of fun and I'm thinking about building a valve cover racer of my own.

At 1:30, winners of the silent auction items were announced and then came the awards for the cars. Sam & Donna Rindskopf's 57 Nomad and our 55 Belair Convertible both won a "Top Pick" award. The last bit of business was the winner of \$295 for the 50/50 raffle. We didn't win the 50/50, but we had a really good time. The location for this show is a bit off the beaten path, but it is a great venue for a car show event where almost everything happens under the shade of solar panels. I think we may want to return to this show next year, so I guess I better get busy and get my valve cover racer ready.

# 3rd Annual Conservative Autobody Car Show

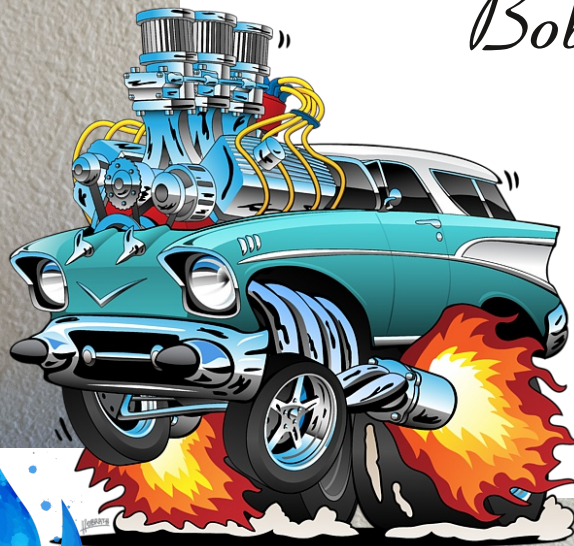

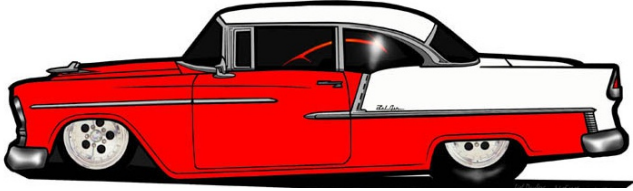

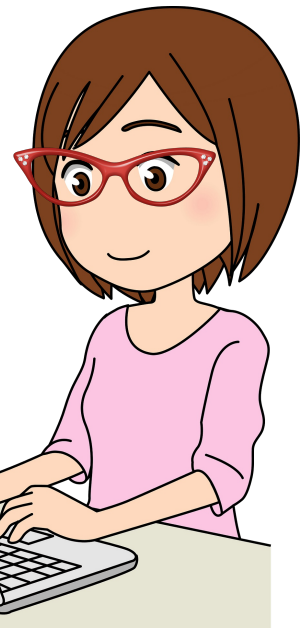
