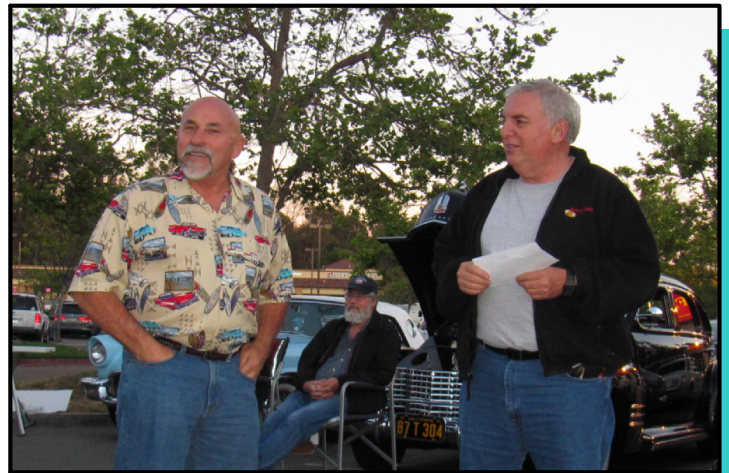
## Revolution Review

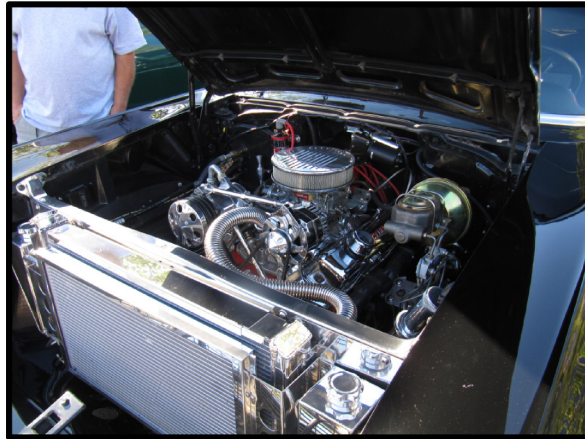

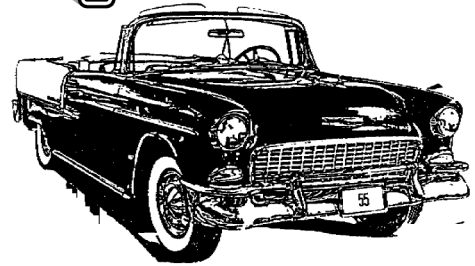


# Nomad Home Again

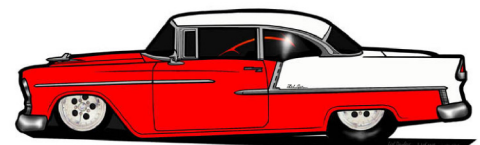

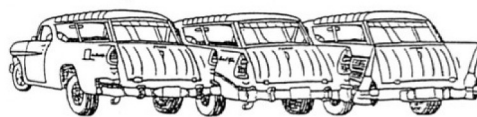

# Household Hints

from Ann Goldberg

Give these household hints a try and you'll solve some common kitchen problems:

Take your bananas apart when you get home from the store. If you leave them connected at the stem, they ripen faster.

Store your opened chunks of cheese wrapped in aluminum foil. The cheese will stay fresh much longer and not mold!

Peppers with 3 bumps on the bottom are sweeter and better for eating. Peppers with 4 bumps on the bottom are firmer and better for cooking.

For a cool treat, make brownies as directed. Melt Andes mints in a double broiler and pour over warm brownies. Let set for a wonderful minty frosting.

Add garlic immediately to a recipe if you want a light taste of garlic and at the end of the recipe if your want a stronger taste of garlic.

Heat leftover pizza in a nonstick skillet on top of the stove, set heat to med-low and heat till warm. This keeps the crust crispy No soggy micro pizza.

For easy deviled eggs, put cooked egg yolks in a zip lock bag. Seal and knead until the yolks are well mashed. Add remaining ingredients, reseal bag, and keep kneading to mix thoroughly. Cut the tip of the baggy and pipe the mixture into the egg white halves. Just throw bag away when done -- easy clean up.

Before you use a container of cake frosting from the store, whip it with your mixer for a few minutes -- it will double in size. You get more frosting for your cakes and cupcakes and consume less sugar and calories per serving.

To warm biscuits, pancakes, or muffins that were refrigerated, place them in the microwave with a cup of water. The increased moisture will keep the food moist and help it reheat faster.
