It's been two years since we attended the last Streak hosted by the San Diego Chapter of Over the Hill Gang. Last year's Streak was abruptly cancelled due to the Covid 19 pandemic as was every other car show event in California. So, we were all quite excited to hear the Streak would happen this year, with some restrictions of course.



There was no Thursday night potluck, no Friday night bonfire or DJ by the beach, and no Saturday night live band to dance to. That was kind of a bummer because those are some of the things we enjoy most about this event. There was a DJ, Paul Palombo, playing music starting at noon on Friday and most of the day on Saturday. The big white tent was up but was open on all four sides. No one was allowed inside the tent except for OTHG members working the show. People were not required to wear masks outside.



The big raffle went on as usual with lots of general raffle prizes and a bunch of super raffle prizes where people could put their tickets in for the specific prizes they wanted to win. All raffle ticket sales were just outside the tent boundaries, but otherwise pretty much the same as before. OTHG ladies were selling goodies and coffee at the bake sale on Friday and Saturday.

Saturday lunch was catered as usual, but we weren't able to fill our own plates. Plates were filled by food workers inside the tent, then handed out to the people in line. There were no tickets for drinks, but bottled water was available with the lunch. There were no tables setup for people to sit at. Everyone had to take their food to their campsites, chairs by their cars, or improvise a place to eat.

The little Miss Streak and Little Mr. Hotrod competition went on as usual with about ten boys and girls eight years old or younger competing for the prizes. They were cute and every contestant left with a prize. Awards for the "Top Ten" cars were chosen by OTHG members and presented as in past years.

Rod & Nancy Hildebrand, Tom & Nancy Geiman, and Linda & I decided we would camp out at Campland this year starting on the Wednesday before the show and take a couple days to relax a bit. Rich Correia came to camp the next day. Don Perkins didn't camp, but he came Friday and Saturday with his '58 Buick station wagon. Since Wednesday was Cinco De Mayo, we made tacos, beans, etc. for dinner. And we made bar-b-que'd hot dogs and burgers the next couple days.



On Friday morning, cars were allowed on the grass and about 30 cars from north county arrived early wanting to be parked together. We got up early too and put our classics out on the grass. The Hildebrand's brought their turquoise '55 Belair sedan, the Geiman's brought their white '65 Chevelle, Linda brought her '69 Chevy C20 truck and I brought my '55 Chevy Belair convertible. We were parked near the front beside the stage where all the cars got plenty of attention. The grass area was completely filled with cars on Saturday and There were around 240 entries.



We started Saturday by participating in the Poker Walk with the rest of our group. We watched the lady in front of us pull four aces to win the grand prize of \$50. Three Kings won second prize of \$25. Linda had three jacks and Tom had two pair, but their hands weren't good enough to be in the money. Raffle tickets were drawn hourly all day long and I think Rich Correia and Don Perkins each won at least five times. The rest of us, not so much.



In previous years, we were able to sign up for next year's show. This year was different. Bill Hogue of Over The Hill Gang said they fully intend to do a show next year, but there seems to be a little doubt about that. OTHG is going through some internal changes and will no longer be a non-profit organization. Because this process will bring changes over the next

few months, they decided not to collect registration fees for next year's show at this time. Instead, previous attendees will receive an email at some point to register for the show if indeed there is a Streak 48.



The weather all week long was very nice, a bit overcast in the morning, but plenty of sun after that. Sunday was a very nice sunny day and there were no Streak activities at all. We just relaxed and enjoyed Campland until it was time to pack up ahead for home.

As usual, this show went by way too fast. We did have a lot of fun with our T5R group, but it could be even better if more T5R members came down to enjoy the weekend with us. Looking forwards to seeing all of you next year, whether you come to camp or just for the day.

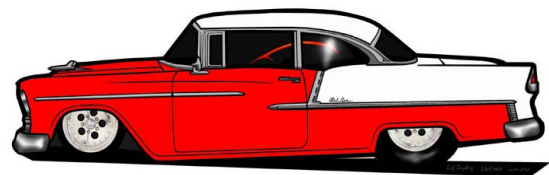


