

The Kitchen Scoop on Tasty Cake and Fruit Combos

Some folks just seem to come across food hacks more easily than I do. Or, they instinctively know what unusual things you can combine to create something tasty and are willing to give it a try. I'm not that adventuresome in the kitchen. My friend Patty is. And, so was her

mother-in-law. Mrs. Hoerner provided the chocolate-cherry cake recipe. Patty's responsible for the apple-spice version. I have not had the opportunity to try either of these yet. (Harvey and I are on one of our jags of trying to eat healthier.) However, Patty swears by both of them, and she has never steered me wrong,

Easy Chocolate-Cherry Cake

- 1 Box chocolate cake mix, whatever is your favorite
- 2 Eggs
- 1 teaspoon Almond extract
- 1 Can cherry pie filling

Preheat oven as directed. Mix these four ingredients together well. (Do not add any other ingredients called for on the package.) Prepare a 13x9-inch or Bundt cake pan as per the box. Bake as directed for the time specified for your pan size.

If desired, give the cooled cake a light sprinkling of confectioners sugar prior to serving. Or, if you're feeling especially decadent, serve each slice with a dollop of whipped topping.

Easy Apple-Spice Cake

- 1 Box spice cake mix
- 2 Eggs
- 1 Can apple pie filling

Preheat oven as directed. Pour pie filling into the mixing bowl and using a knife, kitchen shears or pastry blender, break the apple slices into smaller pieces. Add the eggs and cake mix. (Do not use any other ingredients listed on the cake mix package.) Stir until all are well combined. Prepare a 13x9-inch or Bundt cake pan as per the box. Bake as directed for the time specified for your pan size.

If desired, give the cooled cake a light sprinkling of confectioners sugar, and an even lighter sprinkling of cinnamon. Or, dollop each slice with whipped topping and a bit of cinnamon




