

This year's annual Good Guys Show began with the Poker Run on Thursday. After signing in to get our Good Guy credentials and having the usual conversations with friends from local car clubs, we headed across the street to the fairgrounds parking lot. The local San Diego Over the Hill Gang was in charge and after collecting our first cards, twenty-one cars headed out on the cruise following a yellow '55 Chevrolet lead car.





The first stop was the Joe Martin Foundation Craftsman Museum in San Marcos where we drew our second card. The purpose of this museum is to honor the great contributions made by craftsmen throughout the world and focuses on miniature engineering of almost mechanical and some anything stationary. The museum was filled with meticulously crafted working miniature car engines, airplane engines, vehicles of all types, matchstick models of buildings & bridges and many other miscellaneous interesting and unique items. The back wall had over a dozen different types of working steam engine models, each one spinning in motion for everyone to see. If you are in the area on a day when the museum is open and you have an hour or two, it is worth stopping by to see. There is no admission fee, but they do accept donations. Additionally, items on display change from time to time and on some days, they have one or more people working in the machine shop where you can watch them making miniature parts.





After leaving the museum, we were routed to the coast and down Highway 101 with a stop at the Pelican Point to draw two more cards. By then, the skies were mostly clear with only a few clouds and temperature was near perfect. It was a nice cruise back to the Del Mar Fair parking lot where we drew our last card. Unfortunately, even though Wayne started out with two aces, we once again came up a card short of a winning hand, but the drive was really nice.



Saturday, of course, is the busiest day of the show and we arrived around 8:30. As we made our way into the grounds, we noticed the area where we usually park was taken up with the autocross track. Parking was already getting filled up, but we found a spot next to Tim Beall and his '57 Black Widow. Mike Clark from Classic Chevys was there too. We were told that people were in line to get in as early as two a.m. to get a prime space along the main street. Apparently, Rick Heckman from Classic Chevys was one of them, sleeping in his car until the gates opened.



Right after we arrived, the autocross kicked off with a wide variety of muscle cars accelerating, braking & sliding around the track hoping to complete the course in record time. There was a meet & greet for Don "The Snake" Prudhomme and Tom "Mongoose" McEwen, signing autographs at the clock tower, and Lil Elmo and the Cosmos provided some live entertainment at the Plaza De Mexico.

We started by going through the buildings to see the vendors and indoor cars. For the most part, it was all of the same vendors as seen previous years, but there were a lot of cars we had not seen before. There were some really nice and high-end cars to admire. We could not help but notice how many tri-five Chevrolets were at the show, both inside and out. We can't remember when we saw so many '55 Chevys at one show.



After finishing the last building, we were getting tired and hungry, so we decided to partake in the fairground cuisine by purchasing a bbq beef tri-tip sandwich. We took our food back to the car and parked ourselves in our chairs. The beef wasn't near as good as the peppered tri-tip we get in Yuma, but it did do the job.



While resting and watching the people and cars go by, Joe & Donna Keller, Steve & Debbie Spirkoff, Rod Hildebrand and Don Perkins came by to visit with us. And a little later, Sam & Donna Rindskopf, who by the way are headed for Hawaii for two weeks, came by to share the latest updates on their '57 Nomad. 


