Claudias Corner

For those who like to cook and bake, Spring is a wonderful time to bring out the mixer and whip up a great dessert after the long Lenten fast. Here is one of my favorites that you can decorate with coconut flakes and jelly beans for a sweet Spring treat. Claudia

PIG PICKIN' CAKE

- 1 (18.5 ounce) package yellow cake mix
- 2 (11oz) cans mandarin oranges, drained
(Reserve ½ of the juice)
- 1 cup chopped walnuts
- 1 (3.4 oz) package instant vanilla pudding
- 1 (15 ounce) can crushed pineapple
- 1 (16 ounce) container Cool Whip/thawed

Directions

- § Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Grease and flour 3 - 8 inch pans.
- § Prepare cake mix according to package directions with the addition of mandarin oranges and nuts.
- § Pour into 3 - 8 inch pans. Bake in the preheated oven for 20 to 25 minutes, or until a toothpick inserted into the center of the cake comes out clean.
- § Allow to cool.
- § To make the filling: In a large bowl, combine crushed pineapple with mandarin juice and pudding mix. Fold in the whipped topping. Spread between cooled cake layers and over top of cake. Chill in refrigerator.

NOTE: you can use 2 round pans or a 9 x 13" pan instead



The Kitchen Scoop on Boursin Cheese

Cheddar and American were the two cheeses found in the Powell refrigerator on Coe Avenue when I was growing up and our tri-5's were new. The first for cooking, the other for sandwiches. Now I adore almost all cheeses.

Twice recently I've had absolutely delicious meals featuring Boursin cheese — the first a veggie wrap, the second, a salad. They made me curious. What was Boursin cheese? Turns out Boursin cheese is a trademarked version of Gurney cheese available since 1957. A creamy cheese similar to cream cheese. I should have left well enough alone with that nugget of information. But, my eye drifted down to the next Google entry, a food.com recipe for making homemade Boursin-type cheese. No wonder this stuff is delish, it's half butter!

Homemade Boursin-style Cheese

Butter and cream cheese should be a room temperature before you start. Rub all dried herbs between your fingers to release the flavors before adding.

2 Cloves garlic, crushed
8 ounces Butter
16 ounces Cream Cheese
3 Tablespoons grated Parmesan
1 teaspoon Dill
1/2 teaspoon each Marjoram, Basil, Chives, Pepper and Thyme
1 Tablespoon parsley

Mix all ingredients thoroughly. Store, refrigerated, in an air tight container. Great on crackers, with veggies or in recipes.

Veggie Wrap with Boursin-style Cheese

For each wrap layer a sun dried tomato or spinach tortilla with lettuce, sautéed mushrooms, caramelized onion and red pepper and a “finger” sized portion of the cheese. Fold burrito style and enjoy.

Strawberry Fields Salad

Place mixed greens on each plate, center with a large dollop of Boursin-style cheese. Cover with thinly sliced strawberries, a few thin slices of cucumber, chopped pecans or walnuts (candied nuts if you prefer). Excellent with raspberry vinaigrette or your favorite dressing.
