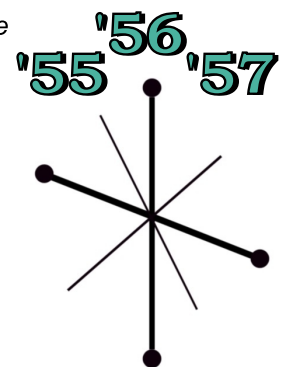

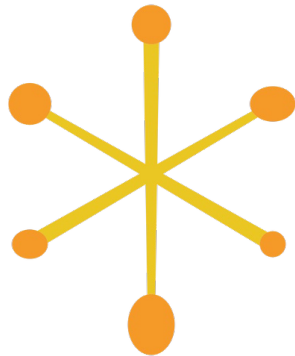
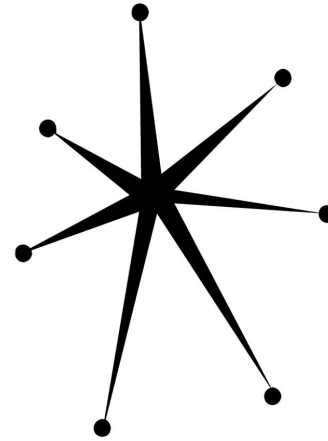

Good Guys 23rd Meguiar's Del Mar Nationals 2024

We are already three months into 2024, and it's time for the Good Guys Meguiar's Del Mar Nationals. In fact, this year's Good Guys show came in early April, a week later than usual because of an early Easter. For the last three years, we have had to deal with rain on one or two days of the show. This year was no different. Thursday was a beautiful day for cruising the San Diego coastline through downtown San Diego and Coronado. It was so nice, we just had to make the cruise in our convertible.

The cruise route was mostly the same as prior cruises, but there were a few route changes along the way making for a more interesting drive. There were about twenty classics and a couple daily drivers in the fairgrounds parking lot at 10 am ready to make the cruise with us including Leon Smythe, Mike Clark, Tom & Nancy Geiman, and Jerry & Cappy Taylor. We cruised south along the ocean by beautiful beaches before going down I-5 to Garnet and making our way up to Mt. Soledad for a brief stop with photo opportunities. Then it was down I-5 to Sea World Drive following back streets to the Malt Shop in Point Loma for lunch. About half of the participants opted out of the second half of the run. Those that continued were treated to some spectacular views of downtown San Diego, along Harbor Drive, past the USS Midway and the Convention Center to the Coronado Bay Bridge. The view from the bridge was spectacular as we made our way to Coronado island, cruising by the water's edge to the Hotel Del Coronado. From there, everyone was on their own to find their way back.

Friday arrived with far less than the perfect weather than we were hoping for. It started with rain, then heavy rain and then more rain. Rain quit shortly after noon, however the wind came up and it was quite chilly. We chose to see the inside cars and vendors. There were some very high dollar builds in the O'Brien building including a spectacular 1.3 million dollar '59 Impala, a 1.7 million dollar Pontiac GTO and a perfect '66 El Camino. There was also quite few cars we see every year along with quite a few new entries. There were also some different vendors this year. Car related vendors were up, but you could also get a new bathroom, solar on your house and few other non-car related items from vendors including the Hula Baby vendor that we see at a lot of other car shows.





Fortunately, the weather on Saturday was beautiful again. There were over 2,000 entries again this year and among them were a few Tri-Five Revolutionaries, including Don Perkins in his black '40 Ford COE, Rod Hildebrand in his red '57 150 sedan, the Geiman's in their '55 blue-flamed Belair hardtop, and of course Linda with her '69 Chevy C20 pickup and me with my '55 Chevy convertible. Shortly after detailing the car and truck, I saw a judge on a golf cart come around the corner into the Tri-Five Chevy row. He went by all the Tri-Fives and made a stop at a coral and gray '55 Nomad from Arizona. He wrote a bunch of notes on his clipboard, then hopped back into his golf cart and left, never looking at any of the other Tri-Five Chevys. A little while later the yellow "Tri-Five Pick" paper was tucked under the wiper of the Nomad. It was so obvious that the Arizona Nomad was pre-picked as the winner before the show even began. If the Nomad had been a really nice car, it may have been easier to accept. But there were at least a dozen entries much more worthy of the award. So, for those who think Good Guys judging is on the up and up, it just isn't so.

We worked our way through all the buildings and vendor displays again and finished up with the food vendors for some lunch. Then we made a trip around the parking areas to see most of the outdoor entries, and there were quite a few we hadn't seen before. Five o'clock came around quickly and with it, all of the buildings and vendors were closing up for the day and it was time to head home.

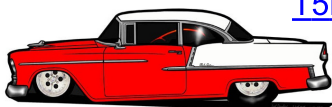

A lot of dollars and time went into building these beautiful cars. We set up our chairs in the entertainment area and around 2:30 pm, the winning entries were paraded past the stage where the announcer told the story of each winner as the drivers were presented with their class trophies. As always, it was a good show, and we had a good time. We're ready for the next event, so bring it on!

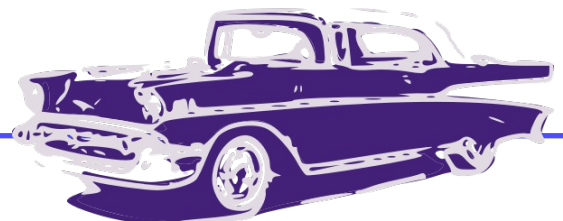
Still a very good news letter. One of these days I will get my 56 Chevy to the show. Jimmy Stewart.
