

Pound Cake with Ice Cream and Fruit

From the menu of the Double Eagle in Old Mesilla, New Mexico, this delight comes to the table in a capped quart Mason jar and is comprised of a bottom layer of chocolate sponge cake stopped with large scoops of peanut butter ice cream, a rich salted caramel sauce, sliced bananas, caramelized roasted peanuts and cream.
